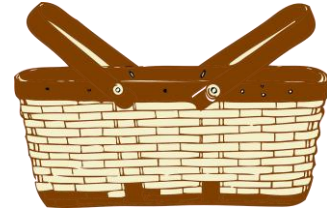

### *Burst Pipe Update*

Butters-Fetting continues to work with us on the burst pipe. Unity volunteers have removed the food and shelving units from the food pantry closet off Fellowship Hall. Thank you to our volunteers! The next step is to remove the asbestos tile and adhesive from the Food Pantry floor. Scott Enterprises will complete this portion of the project. Council approved to remove the tile from the whole room as recommended. This will ensure that the floor will be level when the job is complete, and in the event, they would need to go further to repair the leak, Scott Enterprises will not need to return. Until this portion is completed and they can safely access the pipe, we do not know the final cost for the project. We will continue to keep you posted on the progress of the project and how much additional funds we will need to raise to complete this project. The Endowment Board has given Unity \$10,000 with an additional \$5000 of matching funds to complete this project. Initial estimates indicated that it could cost up to \$20,000 to complete the project.

### *CommUNITY Notes from Council...*

Here are just a few highlights of what your council has been doing and what issues we are facing. Please note that these are highlights and will not include everything.

- Unity's Web Site is being updated regularly. Please check it out at <http://www.unitymilwaukee.org>. Thank you, Tina Latona Lawler, for taking on this project!
- Council approved to form a committee to explore and start the process for Unity to become a RIC (Reconciling In Christ) congregation. This goes in alignment with our mission statement to "...serve and welcome all people" and the work of the ELCA to work for the equality and full inclusion of people of all sexual orientations and gender identities. You will hear more about this process and journey as it unfolds.
- Thank you to all those who have worked in the Clothing Closet and participated in Unity's Welcoming Gifts! This is where we opened our doors for area refugee families to shop for free and take home some of our abundance of clothing, bedding, toiletries, etc. The last event on Saturday, August 20, was a huge success!
- The women's bathroom and roof drainage issues were repaired.
- Unity hosted two groups from Youth Works in our building this summer.
- Thank you for your patience as we continue to work to purchase and install our streaming equipment.
- Council continues to monitor the trends and safety recommendations for COVID-19.

### *William Stark Jones Scholarship*

Application for the William Stark Jones Scholarship (separate from the Endowment Scholarship) are now being accepted. To get your application, email Peggy Latona, Director of Operations and Ministries, at [peggy.latona@unitymilwaukee.org](mailto:peggy.latona@unitymilwaukee.org); or request a copy by phone at 414-744-6311 x203. Keep in mind the deadline for the application submission is **October 31, 2022**.

The grantee(s) must be an active member of the congregation, participate in church activities and assist in the liturgy (liturgy requirement waived for 2020, 2021, 2022) and who will be completing their junior or senior year of high school this academic school year.

The scholarship shall be limited to eligible students planning to acquire further education to a four-year college, technical college, trade school, or another course of school study beyond high school. Criteria used for selection of the recipient shall be: scholarship, scholarship testing and other relevant academic factors, service to the congregation, demonstrated leadership qualities, financial need, character, and personality; but not necessarily weighed in the order stated.

### Stewarding our resources for Jesus' mission

Member giving to Unity's Ministries and Operations thru July 31, 2022 is \$55,921. Thank you for your generosity and for sharing your blessings and supporting Unity's ministries during this critical time.

Total Income	\$123,877.50 YTD	Annual Budget	\$165,531.00
Total Expenses	\$116,702.10 YTD	Annual Budget	\$167,444.23

We find ourselves with a year-to-date gain of \$7,175.40 at the end of July 31, 2022. We have an operating reserve in 2022 from the gain realized in 2021 of \$12,106.44 leaving us with an equity of \$19,281.84. In May, we received a \$19,000 Siebert Grant; in June, an Outreach for Hope grant to pay for the remaining kitchen project expense; and in July a \$2449.64 2020 grant for Covid Relief (the original check did not get to us). In May we also received \$8,231.67 from the Endowment fund for 2021 pandemic related expenses incurred.

In the Property Reserve Fund, we have \$16,079.88 in cash available. In June, we received \$2820 from the Endowment Board to cover out of the ordinary expenses of the flat roof drain cleaning and 2 flush valve replacements (paid in July). Also From the Endowment Board we received \$10,000 for the unknown cost to repair the burst pipe under the Food Pantry Floor that supplies 4 convectors for heating from our boilers. It is estimated that the cost could be somewhere around \$20,000 but until the floor is dug up, we will not know the final cost. We have already received a bill of \$6570.15 in August for the initial problem solving and sectioning off of the pipe to stop the water from continuously running. During that discovery period and containment of the leak, our quarterly water bill from the Fellowship Hall side of the building jumped from \$191 to \$434.

Donations continue as we meet online and in person. Thank you!

The 2022 budget has no Director of Outreach scheduled for the whole year and the budget reflects a loss of \$1,913.23 without the reserve. Budgeted for 2022 is \$92,346 in pledged and unpledged income and a total income of \$165,531. Our expense budget for 2022 is \$167,444.23. Please refer to the annual meeting packet for further information on the budget.

#### 6. Text to give:

Give plus Text: enter 833-894-6696. Enter the amount you wish to give, Click on the registration link, enter your contact and payment information, and tap process. You will get a verification text as well as an email receipt. For future giving, just send a text with the amount you wish to donate and it will process automatically.

Thirty-three households out of 164 households have pledged \$76,955.00 to Ministries & Operations from their abundance. Our budget lists \$92,346, a difference of \$15,391 unpledged. Our Budget leaves us with a deficit (less money coming in than going out) of \$1,913.23 with the Director of Outreach position unfilled.
