Council Plans for Pastor's Sabbatical

Council is planning for Pastor Kevan's 8-week sabbatical this summer. At this time we are working with our synod office to find coverage. Our synod guidelines recommend pastoral sabbaticals be considered after six years of serving in a congregation, and that the sabbatical last for a duration of twelve weeks. After thirteen years of serving with Unity, this will be Pastor Kevan's first sabbatical. His request is for an eight-week sabbatical this summer. His sabbatical will run approximately June 25th thru August 13th.

The word 'sabbatical' comes from the biblical word sabbath, meaning 'rest'. By taking a step back from the demands of leadership, a pastor has the opportunity to reconnect with God to gain fresh vision and energy for equipping long term ministry; while at the same time, the congregation experiences a time of reflection together and visioning for the future. We are hoping that this will coincide with Unity's strategic visioning process. For Pastor Kevan, his sabbatical will accomplish four objectives for longevity in ministry: Rest, Renewal, Recalling, and Reinvestment.

During the sabbatical, Pastor Kevan will receive his normal compensation from Unity's budget. At our Annual Congregational Meeting, a motion was made by the Executive team of Council and passed by the congregation to amend Unity's 2023 Budget to add the necessary \$5688 to cover the contract or contracts needed for pastoral coverage during Pastor Kevan's absence.

Prepare Now for our Plant Sale

We need you to help our church with our first commUNITY plant sale! It will be a hybrid fund raising/neighborhood event by which we raise funds by selling plants and meet with our neighbors. The plan is to gather outside at our picnic tables on Tuesday late afternoons from 4:30pm-6:30pm on May 30, June 6 and June 13 with our perennials, annuals and house plants.

We are now looking for amateur or proficient gardeners to help us create an inventory of plants; perennials, annuals and house plants. There is a limited number of seed packets and plant pots available in the Narthex. You will need to provide the soil and nurturing. If you would rather not plant seeds, we would appreciate house plants or perennials that you donate from your home or garden. For example, one member is starting new spider plants from her existing spider plant.



If you are not into gardening, we still need your help! Join us on these Tuesday afternoons and chat with our neighbors. Please invite your friends, family and neighbors to donate plants or shop at our sale. Most importantly, pray. Ask God to bless our first plant sale, and to bless our neighbors. It is our hope to make this an annual event.

CommUNITY Notes from Council....

Here are just a few highlights of what your council has been doing and what issues we are facing. Please note that these are highlights and will not include everything.

- Unity's Annual Congregational Meeting was held on Sunday, February 5th. Thank you to Patsy Lenz, after finishing 6 years on Council, and Chad Lyden, who served 3 years on the Endowment Board. Welcome to Stacy Davis on Council and Jack Kosmoski on the Endowment Board!
- Our Council and Endowment Board are in the process of committing to hire an outside consultant to help Unity go through a Strategic Visioning Process. We met with representatives from Vibrant Faith Ministries and Leighton Ford Ministries.
- Preparations are being made for sabbatical pastoral coverage when Pastor Kevin takes an 8-week sabbatical this summer.

Property Updates

- Street Angels began using our kitchen on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays beginning December 25th, until their kitchen is back up and running. They experienced a chemical fire in their kitchen at Ascension. It is anticipated that it will take 6 to 9 months to repair it. They delivered and are using a 2-door cooler (refrigerator) to use on the premises since one of our refrigerators has not been repaired.
- In January, one of the sump pump floats (the crock with the previous oil leak) needed to be replaced and in February the water pump on the Church boiler needed to have a capacitor repaired.
- The Food Pantry Closet was graciously painted by Rick Stack. The next step is to apply flooring before the food pantry can move back in. There are plans for that.
- The Food Pantry hours will change hours in accordance with Day Light Savings time on March 15th, from 5pm to 6pm.
- AAC is extending their hours from 9:30am to 2pm beginning February 27th thru May 23rd.
- We have volunteers from Martin Luther High School coming in April to help tidy up and restore the campers clothing closet to its original space. Additional volunteers will be needed to help direct these students. Watch for more information about this.

Strategic Visioning Process Search

Our Council and Endowment Board are in the process of searching and committing to hire an outside consultant to help Unity go through a Strategic Visioning Process. This is a vital process as we (Unity Lutheran Church) look and plan to the future! During the past several months, members from council and endowment met with representatives from Vibrant Faith Ministries and Leighton Ford Ministries. This could be a 3-year process to help us determine, "How do we (Unity Lutheran Church) call, form, and equip a community of daily disciple makers?" We want to make sure we: Serve others in Jesus' mission; Grow our membership; Positively impact and empower our members, neighborhood, community and the world; and Be financially stable. More details will be available as decisions are made.



Unity's Food Pantry hours change on March 15th in accordance with Day Light Savings. The new hours will be 5:00 - 6:00 pm. The current winter hours are 4:00 – 5:00 pm.

Endowment Board News

There are two funds under the Endowment Board's umbrella- The Zirwes Higher Educational Fund and The Mission Fund of Unity. The Endowment Board is primarily focused on the Zirwes Higher Education Fund Scholarships. This year we moved the application process to close on January 29th. We are hoping that will give our applicants a better time frame to apply and also let them know how much money they will have for the fall semester. The scholarships awarded are sent to large public universities as well as small private colleges. We are helping future doctors, teachers, geologists, musicians all achieve their dreams.

The scholarship application has three questions – essentially, they are: See, Do, and Invite. For example, the question for Invite is: When have you given witness to your faith in Jesus and have invited others to join or participate in learning more about Jesus and serving our commUNITY? In their answers, applicants provide specific personal examples of ways they have invited people to experience Jesus in their interactions through the conversations and acts of service they share together.

Perhaps this gives a better understanding of what the Endowment Board does. It is an amazing ministry to be involved with. We help change lives that then change lives. We never know where those ripples in the pond go, whom or what they touch.

Stewarding our resources for Jesus' mission

Member giving to Unity's Ministries and Operations thru January 31, 2023 is \$. Thank you for your generosity and for sharing your blessings and supporting Unity's ministries.

Total Income	\$ 10,732.01 YTD	Annual Budget	\$144,935.00
Total Expenses	\$ 13,881.20 YTD	Annual Budget	\$176,346.90

We find ourselves with a year-to-date loss of \$3,149.19 at the end of January 31, 2023. We have an operating reserve in 2023 from the gain realized in 2022 of \$8,984.39 leaving us with an equity of \$5,835.20.

In the Property Reserve Fund, we have \$12,254.74 in cash available. We have received from offerings from the congregation earmarked: \$5080 towards the burst boiler system pipe.

The 2023 budget has no Director of Outreach scheduled for the whole year and the budget reflects a loss of \$31,411.90 without the reserve. Budgeted for 2023 is \$97,110.00 in pledged and unpledged income and a total income of \$144,935.00. Our expense budget for 2023 is \$176,346.90. Please refer to the annual meeting packet for further information on the budget. Note an amendment to add \$5,688 for the Sabbatical project was voted on at the Congregation Meeting, increasing the loss to \$31,411.90.

Stewardship:

The result of Pledges returned the end of December is 43 member pledges plus 1 non-member. Total pledges to Ministries and Operations \$80,925, Miscellaneous \$355.65 (from amounts given to offset credit card charges from ACH givers and 1 non-member pledge), and Soup Kitchen \$400 (1 member).
