Word from Our Development Steering Committee

The Development Committee continues to explore options for Unity's property. Recently, we met with Alderwoman Marina Dimitrijevic to gain a better understanding of what type of development would be supported. We also spoke with Connor Goggans, who works with the Milwaukee County Coalition for Housing and Homelessness and the warming center about continuing the warming center long term. Council has affirmed and directed the Development Committee to pursue a redevelopment that retains space for the warming center and, if feasible, some amount of housing. We have also restarted conversations with the Bay View Community Center about a potential partnering. Our next steps will be to meet with developers and obtain renderings. We are still hoping to be able to have a first draft of a plan ready for Council to bring to the congregation by the end of spring.

The Development Steering Committee was formed with the task to implement the necessary steps to achieve redevelopment plans for Unity's property. The Committee members are: Jake Schroeder (chair), Laura McVann, Jack Kosmoski, Pastor Kevan, and Unity's owner representative, Derek Taylor.

Spanish Ministries and Worship

Dear siblings, the church is a place for everyone where they are welcome and accepted, regardless of their immigration status. On each of the first Sundays of January and February we had a participation of 11 people in worship. Many of our brothers and sisters do not participate for fear of being detained by immigration officers if they leave their homes. These 11 members and guests come with the excitement of increasing Latino ministry. Intern Pastor Josefa continues to visit the homes of Latino families, so that they feel that they are not alone, and can be fed back with the message and the word of God. At the same time, she continues studying at Wartburg Seminary, and she has begun her Clinical Pastoral Education for pastoral care. Intern Pastor Josefa remains on track for ordination. Unity's Spanish service takes place on the first Sunday of each month at 12:00 noon. English translations of the service are provided to those who do not speak Spanish. A delicious lunch is provided after every worship service. Join us! The next services in Spanish are: March 1, April 5, May 3. Love invites you!

News from Endowment

The Endowment Board met in January and are pleased to announce that we awarded 11 scholarships to Unity members: Kymarie, Olivia, Anna, Ava, Andrew, Bryson, Amber, Oliver, Zeke, John, and Lucy. Six scholarships were awarded to members of St. Stephen the Martyr, and we continued to support Ndelekwa's education in Tanzania. We joyfully offer our prayers for their continued pursuit of their educational goals. In addition to the scholarships, the board created a working 2026 budget that includes continued support to Unity with money set aside for a future vicar opportunity, emergency building needs, CommUnity Outreach Education, educational sabbatical experiences, and reimbursement to the Mildred Raasch fund. This year we expanded our support and included money for Unity youth to attend Crossroads Camp, Troop 79 camperships, Unity's food ministry, increased our general benevolence, and the UWM Cornerhouse. We continue to provide Unity an opportunity to receive an additional \$5000 for matching a fundraiser for Unity building needs. We will complete our pledge of \$44,800 for Leighton Ford with our final payment of \$1508.91. Our operating budget for 2026 is \$181,196.33. We are blessed to continue to honor the intent of the gift from the Zirwes while providing support for educational opportunities, Unity's needs, and community partnerships.

CommUNITY Learning

Our third event in Unity's CommUNITY Learning Series features Becky Aten, who will share their passion and insights for co-creating community environments that are welcoming, accessible, and affirming for the neurodivergent community. Increasingly we are recognizing that many people's brains function, learn, and process information differently. Neurodiversity includes people living with autism, ADHD, dyslexia, Tourette's, and other types of neurodivergence. They often experience certain challenges and struggles, as well as unique strengths and gifts, which contribute a richness in building community together.

You're invited to learn and grow with us on Sunday, April 12th. Becky Aten's presentation will begin at 3pm, followed by a meet-and-greet time afterwards with refreshments.



Making Community Art!

Join us for a very special Kids Time after worship on March 8th, as we make a public art installation with La Familia de Arte's Unity Bridge Project! (Adults are invited and encouraged to participate, too.) We will hear the story of Open Housing with pictures and a video, discuss our reflections, imagine images that best express the message of unity, and then decorate a ceramic tile for the mural. La Familia de Arte is working with community organizations to produce a glazed tile mural that will be mounted to the fencing along the 16th Street James E. Groppi Unity Bridge. The story of the Open Housing Marches can be a powerful invitation to greater unity in our city. Over the next 3 years, 200 diverse community organizations from the north and south sides will collaborate by drawing inspiration from the 200 days of marches nearly 60 years ago. Remembering the love, commitment and courage modeled by the marchers can breathe new life into our community and help us hear the call for "Unity Today & Beyond".



Outreach Ministry News

ROMANS 12:13: "Share with the Lord's people who are in need. Practice hospitality."

Serving with Unity's outreach ministries is a great way to put these words of scripture into practice. Congregation members from area Lutheran churches including Unity, Whitnall Park, St. Stephen the Martyr, and St. Luke's, our friends and relatives, neighbors, students from high schools and universities, police officers and even our Alderperson give their time in many ways: cooking, socializing, serving, dining, cleaning, and staffing our Clothing Closet. We are thankful and blessed for our volunteers! Our Clothing Closet ministry is valuable to many who need season appropriate clothing and it is open Wednesdays from 5pm-6pm. Our Food Pantry is an essential supplement to help provide nutrition and sustenance for those in need of food, also operating every Wednesday from 5pm-6pm. The CommUNITY Meal continues to provide healthy, nutrient rich dinners every Wednesday. Our two monthly hot meals – held on the first and third Wednesday evenings from 5pm-6:30pm – serve over 125 guests, and on the other weeks, our To-Go meals distributed through our Food Pantry benefit approximately 40 guests.

We have a new meal ministry: breakfasts! When the winter temperatures get so dangerous that the warming center extends its hours into the daytime, we serve a hot breakfast for our guests. We served 5 breakfasts this winter, and they were greatly appreciated.

Where does the funding come for our CommUNITY Ministries? Our food ministries; including Active Adults, receive grant money from the Siebert Foundation which allows us to purchase food from Feeding America. This is great but does not frequently allow us to access dairy, fresh fruits, nuts, spices, vegetables, coffee, beverages, and desserts; so other funding is essential. We have been blessed by many financial contributions to help us from our partner churches including Adoration Lutheran, local businesses and organizations including Clementines Bar, Kleczka Funeral Home, the Bay View Lions Club, Gather Bakehouse, as well as neighbors and friends giving generously.

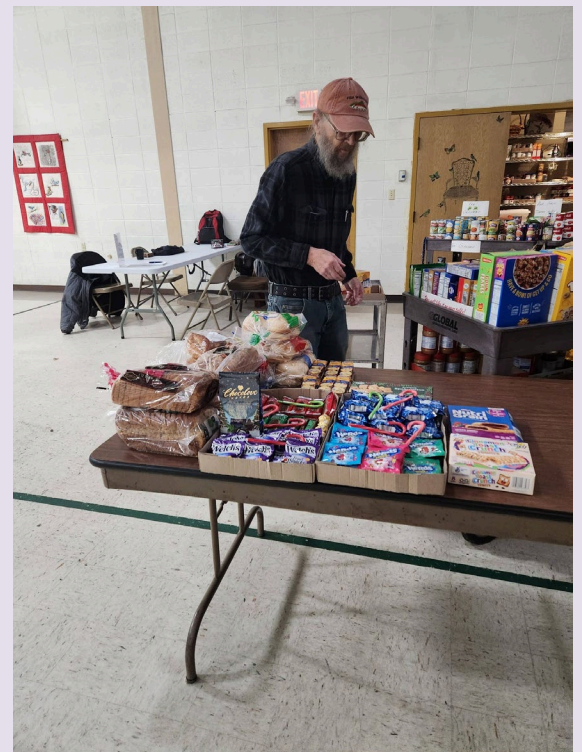
